MILESTONE MONTH


A huge **THANK YOU** to every single person who helped make the week of 17th October a record breaking week, and a milestone month for the business.


PARTY TIME

We teamed up with the learners at Oastlers special school to help create a mural based upon plastic waste, that will be part of their entry.

The mural idea stemmed from the canteen mural at the Orean Beauty site, commissioned by General Manager Chris. We took inspiration from this idea and could see how a mural allowed the learners to be educated about sustainability, as well as design and paint a piece of art that can be added to their portfolio. The mural will be officially unveiled later in the year and displayed on the outside of the Stubs Beck building. The mural will convey the message of mindful manufacturing for the future.
